

Orchard View Pool Rules

- 1. No one will be permitted in the pool unless Lifeguards are on duty and on the deck.**
- 2. Running, pushing, wrestling, or other activities causing undue disturbance are prohibited in the club.**
- 3. No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the pool.**
- 4. IT IS EVERY MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP OV CLEAN, not just the staff's duty. All trash, refuse, cigarette ashes and butts shall be placed in containers provided by the Club. Gum chewing is discouraged within the pool grounds.**
- 5. Swimmers must wear proper swimming attire in the pool; no street clothing.**
- 6. Spitting or spouting of water and similar unhygienic action is prohibited.**
- 7. The following special rules must be observed in the DIVING WELL:**
 - a) Non-swimmers (no band) will be allowed in the diving well ONLY WITH AN ADULT OR APPROVED BABYSITTER IN THE WATER WITH THEM, and with the approval of the Lifeguard.**
 - b) Swimming in the diving well is only allowed with the approval of the Lifeguard and only when no one is using the diving boards. Reserve diving well at snack bar.**
 - c) Only one person is allowed on the diving boards at a time including the diving board step.**
 - d) Do not hang from the edge of the diving board or dive/jump to the side of the diving board. You must jump straight forward, not towards the side of the pool.**
 - e) No excessive springing or bouncing on the diving board.**
 - f) A diver must wait until the previous person has cleared the water in front of the board.**
 - g) Diving at all times is at the divers own risk.**
- 9. Only one person is allowed on the tube slide at a time including the stairway. Wait until the previous person clears the area in front of the slide.**
- 10. All children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult or authorized babysitter (14 years or older).**
- 11. All children 12 and under are restricted to the shallow part of the pool until their swimming ability is tested by a Lifeguard or Pool Manager. Any child who can swim one lap (25 yards), tread water for one minute and dive or jump off the diving board will be issued a wrist band which allows the child to use any area of the pool without being accompanied by an adult. OV will supply the band at no charge, however if a swimmer does not have his/her band, they will be charged \$1.00 for a new one. The test must be taken every year.**

12. At the discretion of the Lifeguard, an “adult swim” may be called wherein all children must clear the pool.
13. The Lifeguards will exercise general supervision over the baby pool, but they are not responsible for anyone in this baby pool area. Only children 6 years and under will be permitted in this pool.
14. Children who are not toilet trained must wear leak-proof swim diapers or leak-proof undergarments.
15. The Lifeguards are present for the protection of members and not to serve as babysitters. Excessive loitering at their stations including the office area is prohibited. No game playing in the office area.
16. For parties held during regular business hours, guest passes will be required of all non-members. There will be a \$10.00 deposit required for these parties, which will be returned by the management after the grove has been properly cleaned. Only one time may be reserved for a party. No raindates. To obtain information about an after-hours pool party, please see the Manager for scheduling and fees.
17. All persons using the Club facilities do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The Club, Directors of OV and/or Management does not assume responsibility for any accident, injury, loss or damage to personal property or any other loss incurred in connection with such use.
18. Members will be held responsible for all actions of (and shall accompany) their guests at the pool at all times.
19. The entire facilities of the club are under direct supervision of the Directors, Manager and Lifeguards. They have the authority/duty to evict anyone from the pool for the day after fair warning of misconduct. Repeated offenses may subject the offender to suspension of club privileges as determined by the Board of Directors.
20. Members shall direct all problems including injuries to the Pool Manager or to Lifeguards on duty.
21. Head Lifeguard or Manager reserves the right to close the Club without notice due to inclement weather, health or safety conditions.
22. Guest Regulations and Fees:
 - a) Members shall accompany their guests at all times and shall be responsible for their actions.
 - b) A person can only be a guest a total of five (5) times during any one season.
 - c) Guests under the age of 12 must comply with the color band policy.
 - d) The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of guests permitted to enter the Club as well as to change the guest policy.

Guest Fees:
